- 1. Fence Project:
 - a. Discussed vendors, Elite & Bravo. Bravo was questioned about permitting costs which could conceivably be 10% of fencing costs. Bravo said that it could be that amount but Clearwater City seldom imposes this amount. No clear answer or set amount was forthcoming. Elite bid a line item of \$1,000 for permit costs.
 - b. Bravo extended validity of bid for an additional 48 hours (new expiration date is 6/4/22) after that deadline the amount would increase at least 10%. Elite has yet to respond to TC's questions.
 - c. After review the financials, Woodlake has \$189,000 for fence project.
 - d. Discussed going over fence project budget. Discussed an assessment and/or building any overages into 2023 budget.
 - e. TC to call both Bravo and Elite to confirm quotes.
