Looking Forward

Fencing Project to begin. The board will begin the process of starting the project to replace Woodlake's fences by reviewing the quotes received from vendors at the January meeting (1/20/2022). Kim has been diligently contacting vendors to supply the board with quotes for both vinyl and wooden fences. Although wood fences would have the advantages of reasonable cost and a quick turn around time , the vinyl fencing, although more expensive, has a longer lasting timeline before having to be replaced. Another issue with replacing the fences with vinyl is that a community vote would be needed to achieve the fence replacement and would cause a delay in starting this project. Please attend the board meetings to see this vinyl vs wood discussion as well as what the cost will be to accomplish this project. The next meeting of the board is Thursday, January 20, 2022 via zoom.

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The Board of Directors would like to hear from the residents of Woodlake. They are requesting that you provide feedback to the board; this feedback could be anything that disrupts the harmony of Woodlake. For example if you notice broken or damaged sprinkler heads, trash and/or garbage not being disposed of properly, abandoned or commercial vehicles .
